Today's gospel happened on the Sunday after Easter. When the risen Jesus had appeared to the Apostles on Easter Sunday, the apostle Thomas was not with them. Thomas refused to believe that they had seen Jesus alive again until he saw Jesus and the mark of the nails with his own eyes. When Jesus appears again the following Sunday, Jesus tells Thomas to touch his wounds and put his hand in his side, Thomas says: My Lord and My God". Jesus says "Blessed are those people who have not seen him but believe." That is us, isn't it?
