**THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT "C"** – In our first reading today, we read about Moses and the burning bush and how Moses was puzzled that the bush was in flames but not destroyed. God spoke to him from the bush and asked him to remove his sandals from his feet because he was standing on holy ground. God asked Moses to lead the Jewish people out of Egypt. He told Moses to tell the people that "I AM" sent him to them. In the gospel Jesus is teaching the people. He is essentially telling the people repent and change their lives and do good.
