PASSION (PALM) SUNDAY – Today, Passion Sunday begins the most holy week of the year. On Holy Thursday, we remember Jesus giving us the Holy Eucharist to be with us always. On Good Friday, Jesus dies on the Cross for our salvation and is buried in a tomb where he will remain until his resurrection from the dead.

TODAY – Meeting after Mass.

TOMORROW, Monday, March 28th – Chrism Mass at St. Joseph Basilica at 7:00 P.M. We must arrive by 6:30 P.M. After 6:45 P.M. your seat may be given to others. If you wish to attend, please see Sister Elizabeth for your ticket. You must have a ticket to enter the Church for the Chrism Mass because there are so many people from all over the Archdiocese of Edmonton.

April 1st – Holy Thursday – Mass at 7:00 P.M. with hearing

April 2nd – Good Friday – Service at 3:00 P.M. with hearing.

Reminder: Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. No meat and one full meal and two smaller ones on that day. No eating between meals.

April 4th – Easter Sunday – Mass for the Deaf at 11:30 A.M.

Sunday, April 11th – On this day the Providence Associates will have a luncheon for St. Mark's like they did during March for the last few years.

Mass and the Eucharist are not something we are only watching; it is something we are doing together. At every Mass, when the bread and wine are placed on the altar, we are saying in effect to God, "This is my body...my blood.... my whole life, with all its joys and sorrows. I offer to you as Jesus offered his life on the cross, trusting that in your hands, all will be well.
